VINEYARD NOTES:

2015 was an outstanding year for Oregon grape growing. A lengthy, Indian summer allowed grapes unscathed by inclement weather to hang on the vines until they reached peak ripeness. The grapes for PINO Rosé of Pinot come from the Willamette and Umpqua Valleys in Oregon.

WINEMAKER NOTES:

The fresh grapes were gently handled in the winery by either directly pressing the fruit to achieve delicate fruit flavor or allowing the juice of whole grapes to mingle with the skins for 36 hours and drawing off - "saignée" - the lightly colored juice. Fermentation was kept cold to further preserve the exquisite characteristics of the wine.

TASTING NOTES:

The wine has a beautiful soft pink color with enticing flavors of strawberry, cranberry, and raspberry. The finish is long and crisp with ample acidity to refresh the palate.

SUGGESTED FOOD PAIRINGS:

Grilled fish, lightly cooked shellfish, risotto with pancetta and mushrooms, sandwiches, quiche, Indian, Mexican, and Thai cuisine.
