## VINEYARD NOTES:

Again, 2016 was a drought year in California. Crop levels were lower than normal, but this led to fruit with concentrated flavors and character.

## WINEMAKER NOTES:

A deep crimson hue indicates this wine will boast a bounty of character. The flavors are rich and complex with notes of raspberry, plum, chocolate, black pepper and vanilla. The finish is long and pleasing as silky tannins melt on the palate.

## FOOD PAIRING SUGGESTIONS:

Lamb shish kababs, pappardelle with Bolognese sauce, and pepper-crust New York steak.
